- NOTE:** All artists work will be showcased at the dress rehearsal however only 12 participants in each section will progress to the evening show. Artists will be advised immediately after the dress rehearsal if their work is progressing through to the evening show.

- NZ Body Art Showcase and Awards @ 7.30pm plus presentation of awards

## Artists General Rules and Regulations

Commence painting @ 9.00am on Saturday - Complete no later than 3.45pm. act 1 and 4.15pm act 2  
Set up is permitted from 8.00am Saturday morning

Work has to be completed for judging at least 15 minutes prior to your completion time.  
Final judging will be conducted from the catwalk during the 4pm dress rehearsal.

## Music

**Will be provided by NZBAA - you are not permitted to provide your own music**

Each themed section has a different piece of music available to artists about 2 weeks prior to event

## Catering

Light refreshments will be provided by NZBAA but it is advisable to bring snacks, water and juice for yourselves and models.

## Photography

The finished models will have professional photos taken before & after judging by Cactus Photography

## Tickets:

All artists and assistances watch the rehearsal and Judging when possible. If Contestants want to watch the NZ Body Art Evening Showcase it is recommended you purchase tickets from venue ticket box, we are known to sell out.

## IMPORTANT

- ❖ The artist/designer must provide model and all materials needed.
- ❖ Please advise if you require a model as we have some available.
- ❖ All application of art work must be done on the premises of the event.
- ❖ Artists may have one (1) assistant per entry. An assistant is allowed to do **minimal** paint work; they cannot work on details or designs. **Please advise NZBAA management with the name of assistant for security and signing of consent form.**
- ❖ You may brush, sponge, airbrush and use special effects.
- ❖ Prosthetics can be pre-painted and pre-painted underwear is also permitted

## Information for Participants

- ❖ All application of art work must be done on the premises to ensure the authenticity of the art work being judged.
- ❖ Only brands of **non-toxic** body paints and make-up can be used.
- ❖ Prosthetics can be pre-painted but must be applied on premises during preparation time.
- ❖ The use of stencils is permitted. The total application should not be by stencil but rather stencils are used to enhance. The judges will award higher marks for freehand rather than stencil application.
- ❖ Please bring an extension cord and conjunction box if you need power
- ❖ Rehearsal on Saturday afternoon is a full technical rehearsal with lighting, sound and stage choreography, this is compulsory for all models.
- ❖ Artists, Models and Assistants will receive a security pass at the venue on arrival. This must be worn at all times. Access will not be permitted to the venue without a security pass.
- ❖ **Props** are not permitted on the catwalk unless they are able to be carried or worn by the model. Under no circumstances are props to be left on the catwalk.
- ❖ There will be a maximum number of contestants per themed section
- ❖ NZBAA is not responsible for personal items. Security is the care of each individual. NZBAA recommends you to bring only what is necessary and hand all valuables into the Production office at the venue.
- ❖ Electricity and water supplies are available throughout the venue
- ❖ Tables are available for the artists use unless you have specialized or preferred equipment.
- ❖ Art work will be done in allocated areas for judging and security purposes, artists and models need to remain in their designated area.
- ❖ Please leave the venue as you find it.
- ❖ All participants must sign a personal Registration & Consent form.
- ❖ Acceptance of registration is subject to selection and confirmation by NZBAA.
- ❖ No sale of products is allowed at the artist booths. If you want to sell products, posters, photos, cards etc, please notify us and we will arrange a trade area for you according to our guidelines.
- ❖ The models always appreciate some form of warm like a blow heater or hairdryer
- ❖ Disregard of the health and safety rules may result in disqualification.
- ❖ Corporate sponsors may have back-stage viewing
- ❖ Entries must be completed prior to judging. Minimal touch-up are allowed after judging. Final judging will be from the stage.
- ❖ Important Note: You must pack-out and clean your preparation area before judging. All paints etc must be moved to your allocated backstage dressing room.
- ❖ Disregard of the rules may result in disqualification.
- ❖ Use of dry ice, fire or other hazardous props must be discussed with NZBAA prior to event or you will risk disqualification
- ❖ Nipple covers are essential for all female models
- ❖ Merkins and underpants must be placed professionally, camel toes are not acceptable for catwalk performance
- ❖ Judges will not accept models with physical distractions such as large breasts or lose genitals. Please be respectful of your model, judges and audience at all times and ensure these areas are well supported.
- ❖ Do not hesitate to talk to us for advise and professional tricks should you need help
- ❖ **5pm Saturday 1 September** – Catwalk sequencing and full technical rehearsal, lighting, sound, AV, and models. **Attendance by the model is compulsory.** If the model is not available the artist must contact the Artistic Director or Executive Producer to make alternative arrangements.
